WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Students will study a Certificate of Liberal Arts to help build communication skills including writing, speaking and presenting, planning, critical thinking and self-organisation from experts in their discipline.

In Semester 2, the two units offered are: Writing about Music & Introduction to Sociology

The program is offered through two options: • Wednesday Program: Australian Catholic University, Banyo

Thursday Program: Common Ground, South Brisbane

Program details:

- 10 15 students per class
- 1 or 2 subjects per semester (1 to 2 years in total, or longer if needed)
- 2 hour lecture each week over 12 weeks

COST

There is no cost to students. HECS fees are waived, with all lunches and required resources provided. Volunteer Learning Partners assist students in all aspects of study including using technology, accessing online resources and assessment.

WHO CAN APPLY

Those who:

- speak English as an additional language
- have missed education due to hardship
- are returning to study
- are a refugee or asylum seeker
- are a year 12 student and seeking an alternative option

ELIGIBILITY

To apply, you must be able to:

- commit to 4 hours attendance each week
- write a paragraph
- read and discuss a newspaper article
- commit to a 2 hour lecture each week over a 12-week program
